#### **REPORT PURPOSE**

To present Council with the Draft 2012/2013 Annual Budget for Council consideration and priority setting to achieve a balanced budget .

#### BACKGROUND

In preparation for the 2012/2013 Annual Budget the following matters have been taken into account in the preparation of the draft budget document.

#### Shire of Chapman Valley Plan for the Future

The Shire of Chapman Valley Plan for the Future document has been utilised as a Budget working document with projects for 2012/13 included in the Draft Budget Estimates.

#### Shire of Chapman Valley Five (5) Year Building Program.

Council's Building Committee has completed an inspection of the Shires Buildings. Council's 5 Year building Program has been fed into the Draft Budget.

#### Shire of Chapman Valley 2012/2013 Schedule of Fees and Charges

Draft 2012/13 Schedule of Fees and Charges was presented to Council on 20 June 2012 figures incorporated into Draft Budget document.

The proposed change to fees and charges for Fig Tree and Coronation Beach, are to be raised by the CEO for further discussion.

#### Shire of Chapman Valley Community Grants

Subject to budget constraints the application for funding towards the Electronic Scoreboard Nabawa Oval for \$21,060 has been listed on the draft budget for consideration.

#### COMMENT

The Draft version of the Shire of Chapman Valley 2012/2013 Budget Accounting Schedules is presented as a bound document submitted as a separate attachment.

Council Officers are seeking Council input on priorities to reduce the budgeted deficit by approximately 1.5 million dollars to near a balanced budget figure. NB: 2011/2012 End of year Journal adjustments is still to affect the 2011/2012 Carried forward surplus figure.

#### STATUTORY ENVIRONMENT

Council's 2012/2013 Budget documents contain a number of items that require adoption by Council under the Local Government Act 1995. Those are in accordance with:

 Differential rating has been adopted by Council in the past for Unimproved Values based on the land use e.g. UV Oakajee. Council has advertised the proposed differential rates, as required by Section 6.36 of the Local Government Act 1995, and as at the close of business 5.00pm 11 June 2012, no submissions have been received;

- Section 6.33(3) of the Local Government Act 1995 requires that the Minister for Local Government's approval be sought for the imposing of differential rates which are more than twice the lowest differential general rate; (i.e. Oakajee UV)
- Section 6.45 of the Local Government Act a 5.5% interest charge be levied on rates instalments, Deferred Pensioners Rates' excluded;
- Section 6.51 of the Local Government Act an 11% interest charge be levied on all overdue rates outstanding, Deferred Pensioners' Rates excluded;
- Section 6.45 of the Local Government Act an administration charge of \$5 be levied for the second and each of the subsequent rates instalments;
- Section 6.32 (1) of the Local Government Act 1995 the Schedule of Fees and Charges as detailed in the budget document;
- Section 64 (2) of the Local Government (Financial Management) Regulations 1996 that the due date for instalments be set as set out below in the recommendations:

2 Options of two and four instalments be offered.

 Section 6.19 of the Local Government Act 1995 requires a local government to give local public notice of any fees or charges it wishes to impose after adoption of the annual budget.
