



Northampton, nestled in the valley of Nokarena Brook, 47 kilometres north of Geraldton, was awarded historic town status by the National Trust in 1993.

It was declared a townsite in 1864 and is one of the oldest settlements in Western Australia.

A former lead mining centre, its prosperity is now based on sheep and wheat farming.

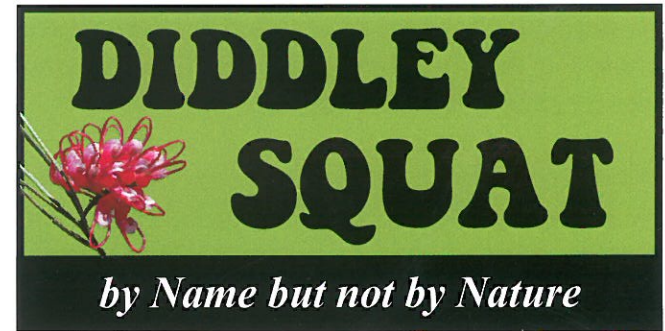

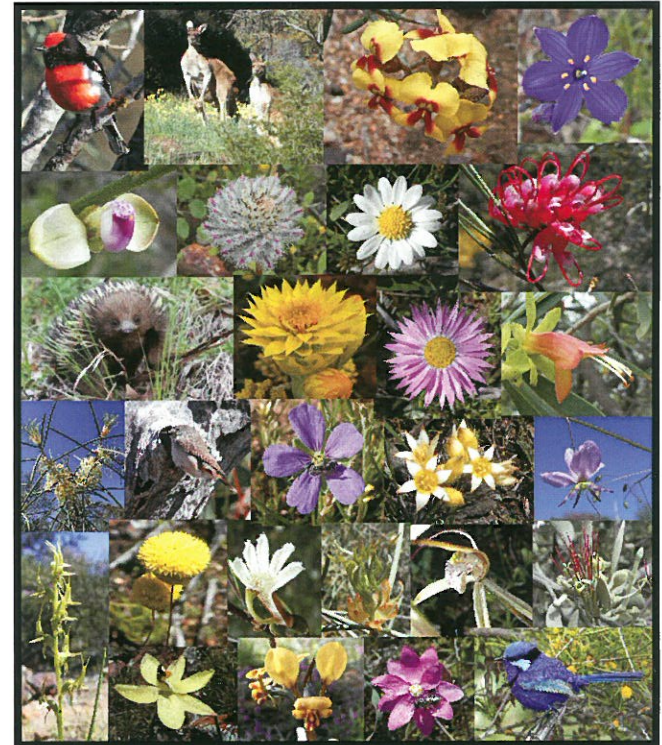


FOLLOW THE SIGNS
