Strategy at a glance:

- Sets a vision for "A thriving, resilient economy that supports growth while preserving local landscapes and identity".

Governance, Collaboration & Partnerships

- Identifies tourism as a major opportunity, anchored in three experience themes: Range & Skies, Coastal Escape, Heritage & Harvest.
- With limited resources, the Strategy focuses on strengthening agriculture and trades as the economic base, growing the tourism, arts and recreation sectors, and attracting community services and administrative industries that currently face barriers to establishing locally.
- Highlights four priority projects for progression and funding: Nabawa Community & Recreation Precinct, Midwest Adventure Trail, Nanson Showground Upgrades, Coronation Beach Improvements.
- Aligns with national, state and regional policy to enable partnerships and coordinated delivery.
