DOG OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The Dog Act 1976 states dog owners must ensure their dog;

- Wears a collar displaying the owner's name, address and council registration tag when in a public place.
- All dogs aged over three months must be registered (Dog Act 1976) and penalties apply for failing to register your dog(s).
- Is under the control of a competent person on a maximum twometre lead when in a public place.
- Is exercised off a leash in designated areas only, with the person in control carrying a leash to ensure the dog can be restrained if required.

NOTES

Your registration fee helps;

- Reunite lost dogs with their owners.
- Contribute to the maintenance of the Dog Pound.
- Support Ranger Services within the Shire of Chapman Valley

Dog registrations must be renewed prior to 1 November.
